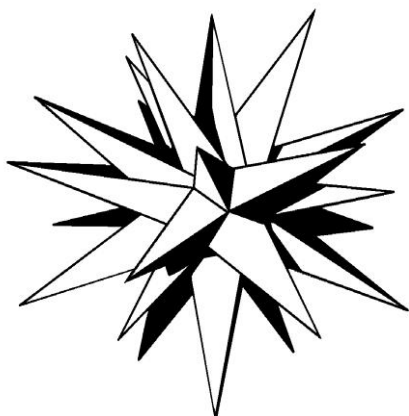

### **Come and see**

When Philip invited Nathaniel to “come and see” (John 1:46), Philip chose to give Nathaniel the opportunity to discover Jesus for himself. Philip had told Nathaniel that they had found the one whom Moses wrote about, the long-expected Messiah. But Nathaniel was contemptuous and displayed his grave doubts. At that point Philip chose simply to invite him to “come and see.” The result was that Nathaniel experienced his own epiphany as he met Jesus, spoke with him, and declared, “You are the Son of God! You are the King of Israel!”

We would do well to emulate Philip, discern the moment when argument would yield no fruit, and recognize that it would be better to invite the person personally to discover Jesus, our Savior and Lord. Further, Philip allowed his relationship with Nathaniel to be the means by which he could extend an invitation to him. Persons will often do what another person asks of them, not because they identify with what is to be done, but because they have a relationship with the one who asked. Relationships can undergird effective evangelism as we seek to bring others to Jesus. Relationships also determine the level of the stewardship of persons who are members of the church. The member’s level of stewardship reflects the member’s relationship not only to the Lord but to the other members of the church.

We can seek to be conscious of the relationships we have with others and let those relationships enable us to lead them to Jesus. We can trust Jesus to do the rest.
