Easter Grave-Cleaning and Flowering

Once again this year the youth and children will be offering their services to help any members, families, or friends of our congregation in the Easter tradition of cleaning graves in God's Acre. This year our flower option is a <u>6 inch potted Red Geranium</u> (\$25 per plant)

Each pot will be wrapped with paper and a bow, and if desired, placed upon the grave requested or you may pick them up Good Friday morning at Calvary.
