Rev. Nola Reed Knouse, Ph.D., is a native of Winston-Salem and a lifelong member of Home

Moravian Church. After studying music and mathematics at Wake Forest University and the Eastman School of Music, she taught at Salem College, Oregon State University, Wake Forest University, and privately.

She began work at the Moravian Music Foundation in 1992, and served as Director from 1994 until retirement in 2022. She was music editor of the 1995 Moravian Book of Worship, and edited/authored The Music of the Moravian Church in America, published by Eastman Studies in Musicology. She earned the Certificate in Moravian Studies at Moravian Theological Seminary, was ordained a deacon in 2009, and consecrated a presbyter in 2015. She has served on various provincial committees, and is on the Board of Trustees of Moravian Theological Seminary and the Tar River Land Conservancy.

She remains active as a flutist, composer, and Moravian band leader. Since her "retirement," she has enjoyed gardening, woodworking, traveling with her husband Paul, and serving as supply preacher at many Moravian congregations.

December 15th - 9 AM - 12 PM


Kids meet at 9am to get organized and have breakfast, then rehearse from 9:30-10:30am and lead worship at 11am.

In the early years we were able to provide home baked cakes, but since Covid we have to provide individually wrapped snack cakes. Calvary's weeks are August 22 and August 29. We need 200 snack cakes such as Little Debbie's. If you would like to provide some of the snacks, please leave them in the kitchen marked as prison snacks. If you would like to provide monetary help please put a sealed envelope marked with "prison cakes" in the collection plate.














2025 Daily Texts
