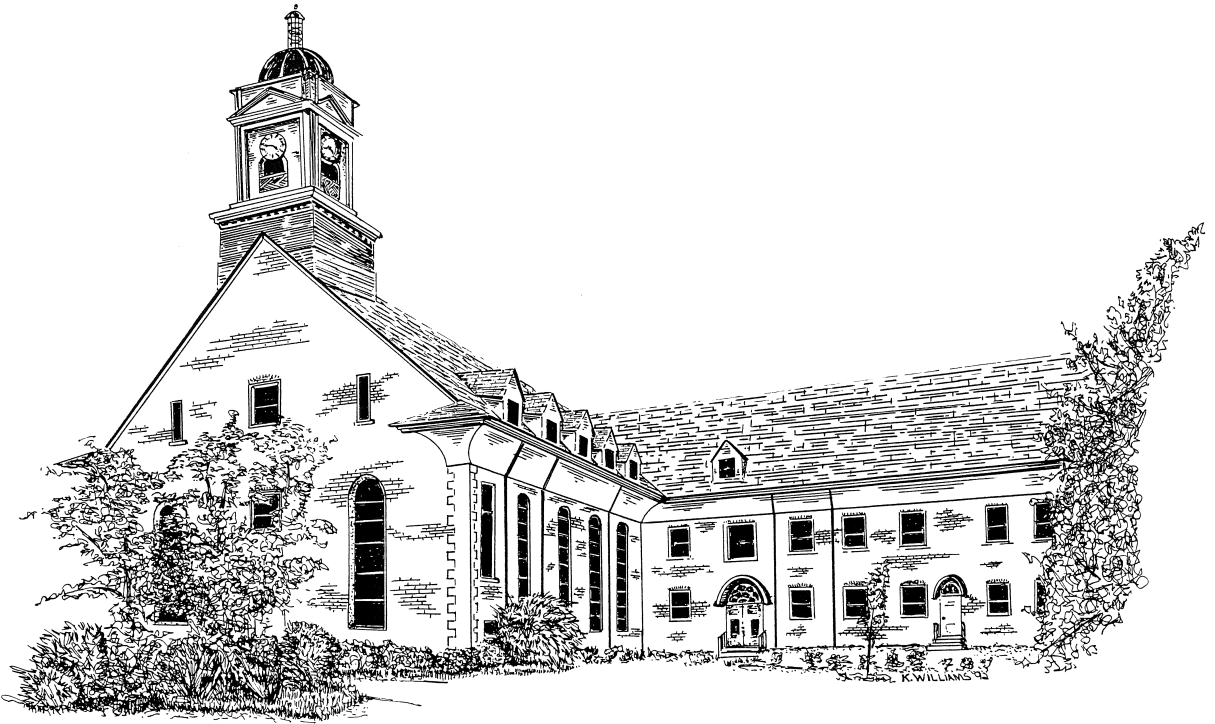


The flowers in the sanctuary are given to the Glory of God and in memory

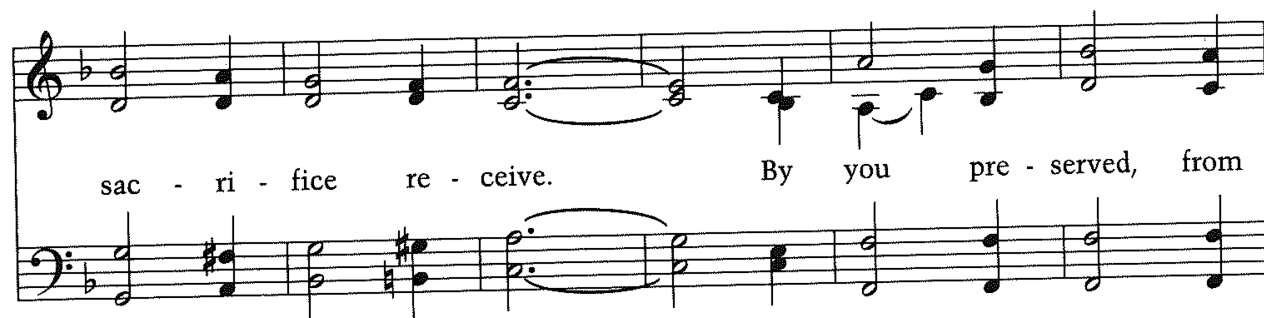
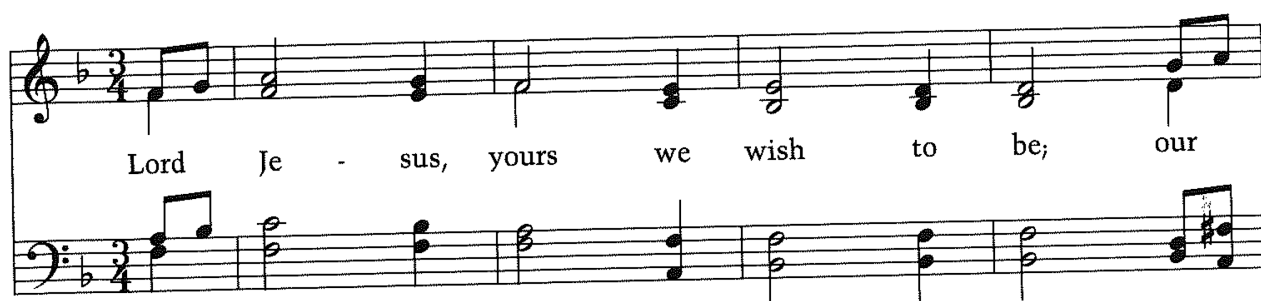


**We hear your call to discipleship. Master, teach us the way we should go.**


Jesus said: This is my commandment, that you love one another as I have loved you. I chose you and appointed you that you should go and bear much fruit, and that your fruit should abide.
