


The flowers in the sanctuary are given to the Glory of God and in memory of Marjorie and Fred Pfohl Crouch by the Crouch's son, Fred.






(Sitting)

Be steadfast, immovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, knowing that in the Lord your labor is not in vain.






