NATIONAL FUND FOR SACRED PLACES GRANT



A program of Partners for Sacred Places
in collaboration with the
National Trust for Historic Preservation

Calvary Moravian has received a \$300,000 matching grant from the National Fund for Sacred Places (NFSP), a program of Partners for Sacred Places in collaboration with the National Trust for Historic Preservation.

This funding will support vital repairs of our slate roof around the dormers, historic clock tower, and steeple. We are one of 30 organizations in the nation in the 2025 grant cycle to receive funding that provides capital grants for repairing and restoring sacred places to congregations of all faiths.

More details about this exciting opportunity will follow after Pastor Chaz & Spencer Bullins receive additional training with the NFSP in mid-November, but for now there are a few ways to make a contribution for this matching grant. Please follow these guidelines to make sure your donations are matched dollar for dollar by the grant.

Methods for Making a Donation

1. **Write a check made out to Calvary Moravian with “Roof & Steeple Repair Project” in the memo and then mail the check to:**

2. **Speak with your bank or investment manager about sending funds to Calvary. This donation must also include a note that it is for the Roof & Steeple Repair project for it to count towards the matching grant. 3. **Go to calvarymoravian.org and click on the giving tab to make a donation and make sure to include “Roof & Steeple Repair Project” in the notes section of the giving portal.**

Since its inception, the National Fund has awarded or pledged over \$33 million to 168 community-serving congregations representing 28 faith traditions across 45 states, the District of Columbia, and Puerto Rico.

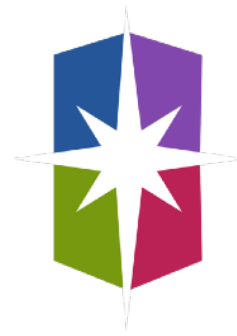
HOLLYWEEN
