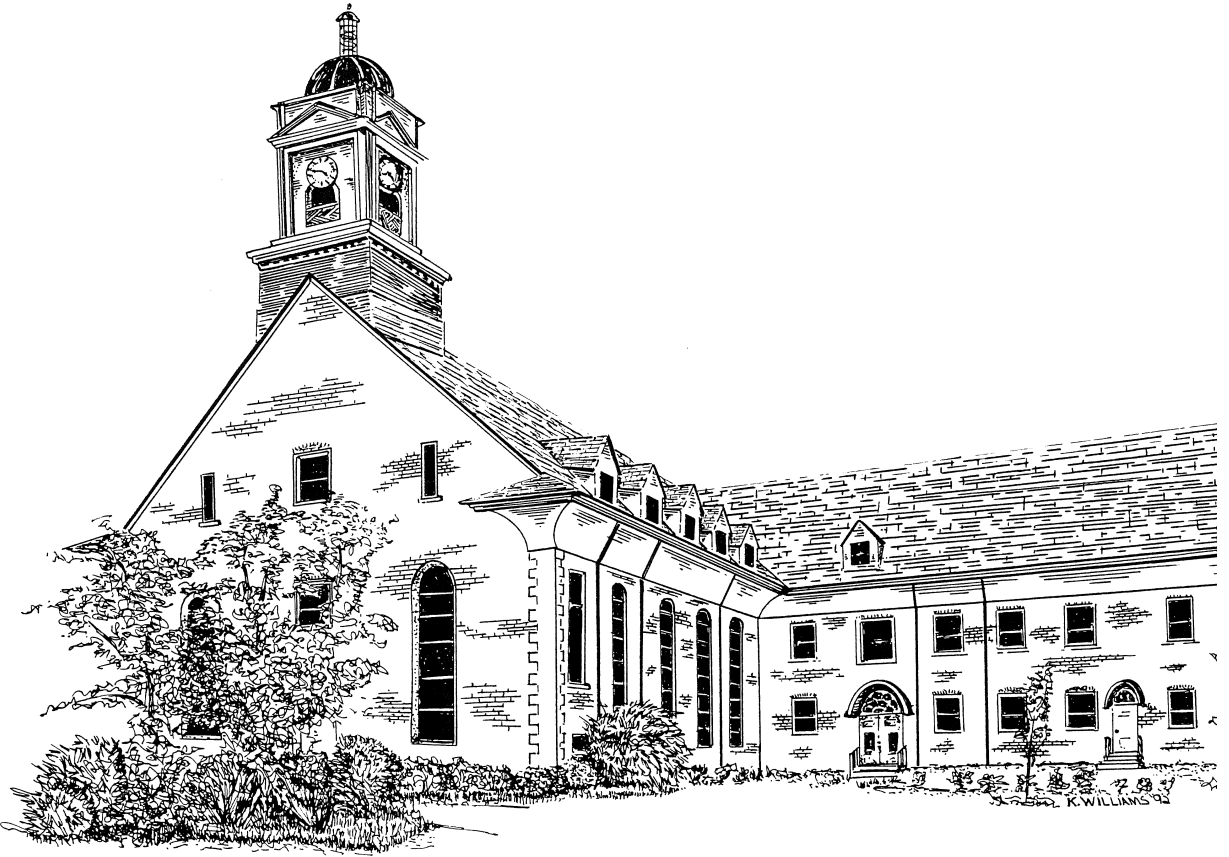

The flowers in the Narthex are given to the Glory of God on this Father's Day in honor of all fathers and all those who nurture children, by the Board of Elders.


We wish all fathers a most happy and blessed Father's Day.

There is no nursery during the summer. Nursery will resume in the fall.




