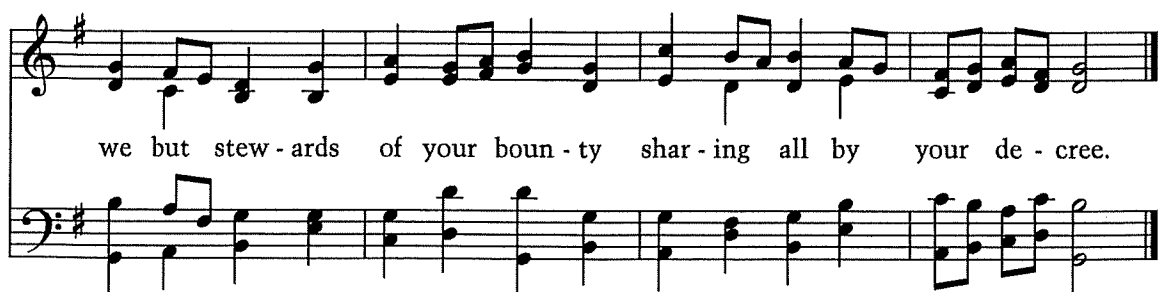
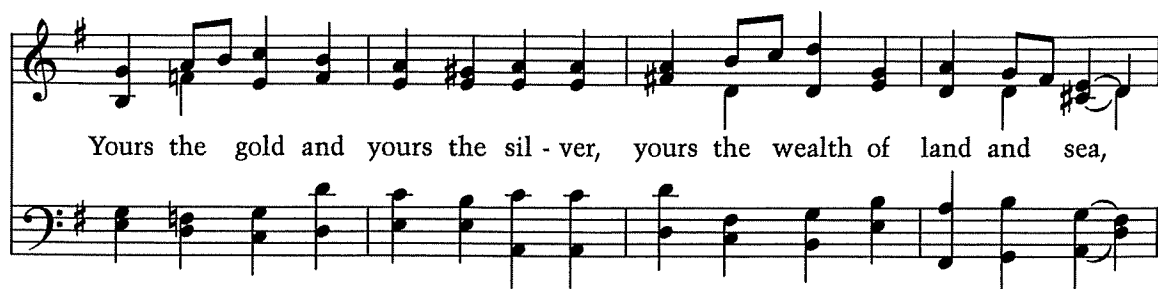
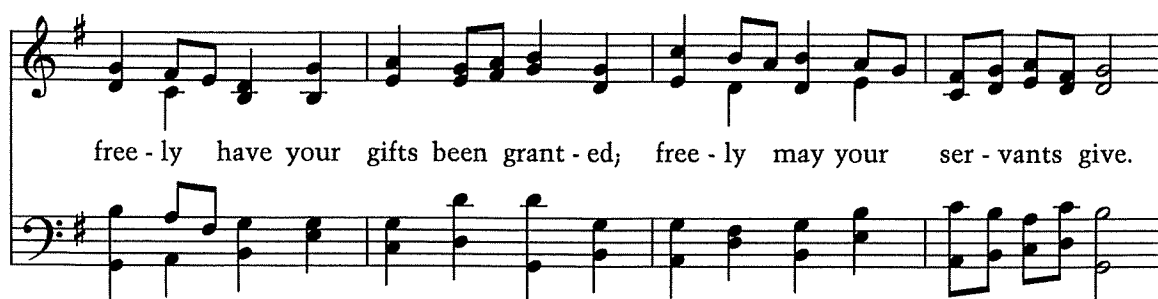
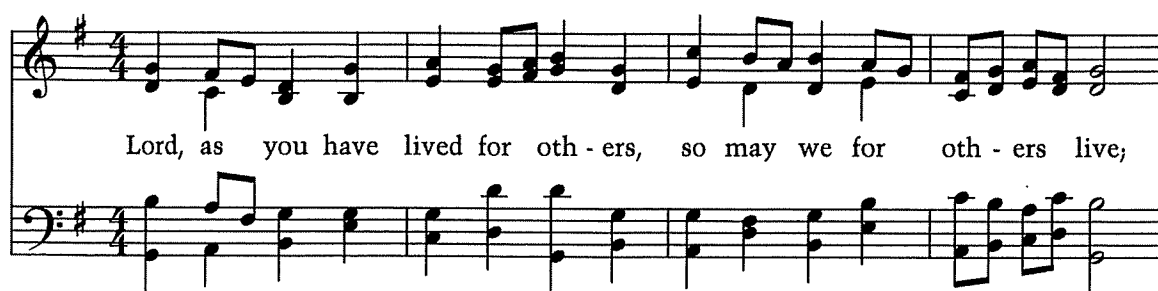
We hear your call to discipleship. Master, teach us the way we should go.
